Good news on construction

In the last newsletter, I expressed the hope that we would be able to sign a lease on the shed site in August so that we could start construction soon afterwards. The good news is that we have now signed the lease, and we hope to start construction on 1st November. If all goes to plan, the building should be up by February next year so that, after a period fitting it out, we can start regular shed operations by Easter 2022.

After 3 years of delays and frustrations, I really should not say things like "we now hope to ..." followed by a specific date—because I have always been wrong. Of course, there are still natural hazards that could interfere; but this time I believe that things really are going to happen more or less to plan.

Our project manager, Tony Tutaki, and the whole of the management team are going to work hard over the next few months to get the shed up. Keep your eye on the shed site and watch us go!
